



Student house "Mercury"

Student house "Mercury" is located in a quiet area of the city within a 25-minute walk from Cracow University of Economics. It takes only a few minutes by bus to get to the Old Town and university. Next to the dormitory there is a canteen, basketball and football playground and student pub "Arka".

"Mercury" is a 10-storey building. Students live in double or triple rooms with shared bathroom and kitchen. All rooms have free internet access. The dormitory has a study room to ensure peace and quiet during the study, room for bicycles and a small grocery shop. Residents can use a television room, party-room, recreation room and a well-equipped gym.



Two double and two triple rooms, shared bathroom and toilet make up the composition of the unit. Standard equipment for one person includes: single bed (80/200cm), wardrobe, a shelf for books, cupboard, table and chair, desk lamp. Each resident receives duvet, blanket, pillow and bed linen changed every three weeks.



There is one kitchen on each floor. Kitchens are equipped with a few gas plates, sink, the table and microwave oven. Refrigerators are not standard equipment in the dorm. Students usually buy their own refrigerators and pots for cooking.

Laundry rooms are on the third and seventh floor.

You can take the following buses to get to the dormitory "Mercury": 105, 114, 129, 139, 159, 169, 405, 217, 246, 247, 257 and 277.

It is very easy to get to the dorm from the railway station, just walk through the gallery ("Galeria Krakowska" shopping centre) and take bus number 105 or 129 from Pawia Street.
