existing contacts. There are many important initiatives; some of the Polish universities are renowned in Latin America and famous for their high quality of education and research.

However, it would be good to consider giving a clear priority (while preparing strategies of internationalization – both academic and national) to the countries of the Latin American region which face similar challenges, but must seek strategic partners outside the region due to the lack of adequate research infrastructure.

The potential of scientific and educational cooperation between Polish and Latin American universities is enormous, unfortunately still not yet fully exploited.
