



# Is this something for me?

Erasmus+ is a program for every student: first, second, or third cycle, regardless of the mode and level of studies.

# I have already been on a student exchange - can I go again?



Yes! Each student, during one cycle (level) of studies, is entitled to apply for 12 months of financing within the framework of the Erasmus+ program. For example, during your undergraduate studies, you can attend two semesters

of Erasmus+ study and/or work placement, provided that their total duration does not exceed 12 months. The same principle applies in the case of master's studies. Each time, you can select a different host institution.

# **Program description**

- Thanks to the Erasmus+ program, students can apply for a placement abroad, for a
  period not exceeding 12 months during each cycle (level) of studies, regardless of the
  type of mobility (work placement or study placement). The total number of months –
  within each cycle of studies includes any previous trips financed from the Erasmus+
  program.
- Each student receives a grant for the duration of the placement abroad.
- You can travel and receive funding more than once.
- The IPO coordinates two programs: Erasmus+: KA103 (mobilities to EU, EEA, FYROM, as well as Turkey and Serbia) and Erasmus+ KA107 (mobilities to other European countries as well as Asia, South America, and North America) with higher funding for maintenance costs and a higher lump sum for travel costs.

### What we consider in the recruitment process?

- · average grades from the entire period of studies
- · results of the language qualification
- participation in classes taught in foreign languages
- work experience (especially involving speaking a foreign language)
- · activity in scientific clubs and student organizations
- volunteering in university units or outside the university
- participation in Mentor/Buddy programs (assistance to incoming international students)



Remember that although having more points increases your chance of a placement at your dream university, there are only two

necessary conditions that you have to meet in order to qualify for the program: (1) minimum 3.4 average grade, and (2) passing the language qualification.

### How to apply?

It's easy! The main recruitment takes place once a year (December/January) for the entire next academic year. Depending on the availability of places (in total, we have several hundred of these), we may organize additional recruitment for the summer semester.


# Step 1

Language qualification

Language qualification entails the submission of a copy of the language certificate and/ or exam report of grade 4.0 and higher at B2 level, or taking the exam organized by the Language Centre for recruitment purposes. Copies of certificates should be submitted at the CUE Language Centre, which also conducts registration for the qualification exams.

### Step 2

Filling online applications, and submitting documents at the International Programs Office by the designated deadline
