





## Food and drink & city life

# Medical service

Generally Krakow is nice, cool city especially for younger. Fortunately, the rate of violent crime is low. Don't be an easy target for pickpockets and don't ask for trouble. Don't be foolish with drugs and alcohol. That's all.

# Climate

Krakow has a temperate continental climate - often have a significant annual variation in temperature with warm summers and cold winters.

# Wi-fi and other applications

In Krakow, as in all other cities in Europe it is sometimes not possible to use absolutely free wi-fi in public places. You must go to some bar or restaurant to use it (and not every bar has such connection).


