

All language courses participants and their legal guardians are obliged to familiarize themselves with the Polish Path Language Course Regulations.

1. If there is a word "University" used in the Regulations, it should be understood as the Cracow University of Economics, ul. Rakowicka 27, Kraków.
2. If there is a word "Participant" used in the Regulations, it should be understood as the participant of the Polish Path Language Course offered by the Cracow University of Economics.
3. The Participant is assigned to a group of his or her choice on the declared level of knowledge, which is checked by the lecturers who are teaching the groups.
4. The Participant can change his or her group level upon his or her own request, or upon the lecturer's request.
5. The size of the group is settled between 8 and 15 persons. During the period of the forming of the group it could be smaller or bigger.
6. The number of teaching hours is settled for 120 teaching hours during the academic year, that is 60 teaching hours per semester.
7. The price and the terms of payments are settled for each academic year. There is a possibility to pay the annual payment in two instalments, separately for each semester.
8. In the case of the Participant's resignation, the return of the payment for the course is possible only in the period of one month from the date of the beginning of the course.
9. The price for the course includes: the payment for the course, tests, administrative service, providing lecture halls, certificate confirming completion of the course, certificate confirming qualification for the course.
10. The Participants who are joining the groups during the academic year pay for the whole semester. The University does not give discounts.
11. The participant's temporary absence on the course, regardless of the causes, does not entitle them to the return of the payment, lowering of the payment or not making the due payments for the course.
12. The University offers the supervision for conducted classes and in the case of stating the teacher's incompetence provides the course with a replacement.
13. When the course is completed, each participant will receive the certificate confirming completion of the course, and after the lecturer's positive assessment, the certificate with a

grade on it.

14. If there are no mistakes in the teaching methodology of the course and the other Participants of the course show satisfactory progress in learning, the University does not take liability for the Participant's individual learning progress.

15. The Participant agrees for gathering his or her personal information by the University and using them for contact purposes. The University does not disclose the Participant's personal data to any companies or institutions.

16. The University reserves the right to publish the pictures taken during the classes conducted on its premises in the booklets, on the web pages or in other advertising materials.

17. The Participant agrees for receiving information from the University concerning the University educational offer to the e-mail address indicated in the application form.
