Sport

Visa and Residence Permit

Students from the EU, the EFTA and Swiss Confederation need only a valid travel document to enter the territory of Poland, while most non-EU students need a visa. Polish embassies and consulates abroad provide detailed information on the rules of entering the territory of Poland.

Health Care

European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) entitles EU citizens to healthcare in Poland on the basis of EU regulations on coordination of social security systems. Students from non-EU countries without the EHIC or any other health insurance may apply for a voluntary insurance from the Polish National Health Fund (NFZ).
