

History





Since 1961, the University has held the authority to confer the academic title of *docent* and to conduct *habilitation* procedures. The first *doctoral* studies were launched in 1962.

The most recent and pivotal change in name and status took place in 2007, when the institution was granted *University rights* and became one of the five public universities of economics in Poland.

Since 1925, the University has upheld the guiding mission: To understand the causes and values of things, to provide a universal education, and to combine professional knowledge with general knowledge of a methodological and theoretical nature.
