C	30	GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	25	SATISFACTORY PLUS - fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	SATISFACTORY - performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	-	FAIL - some more work required before the credit can be awarded
F	-	FAIL - considerable further work is required
