

RECRUITMENT REGULATIONS

- I. Recruitment cycle:
- 1. The primary recruitment is organized in December 2022 and January 2023.
- 2. Recruiters are required to draw up reserve lists of students participating in recruitment.
 - II. Place for submission of documents:
- 1. All necessary documents, a list of which will be drawn up by the partner universities, are to be submitted to the project coordinator at the candidate's home university.
- 2. The project coordinator at the home university enters the persons selected for the project into the on-line application form drawn up by the programme organizer.
 - III. General criteria to be taken into account when recruiting for the programme:
 - 1. English language at a minimum B1 level.
 - 2. Age of majority.
 - 3. Status as a student of the partner school.
 - 4. Have a passport valid for at least six months after entering Poland.
 - 5. Level and field of study are irrelevant.
 - 6. Recruitment must be conducted with respect for equal opportunities and without excluding any social groups.

IV. Additional requirements:

- 1. Only people who have confirmed their willingness to participate in the programme can be entered in the electronic online application of participants.
- 2. Recruited students, due to the law in Poland, have to sign a document regarding permission to process personal data after recruitment.
- 3. Reviewing the documentation and completing the documents/statements and signing them can be done electronically.
