■ JASSO Scholarship

1. Overview

The JAPAN STUDENT SERVICE ORGANIZATION(hereafter JASSO) provides the students who intends to study at short-term study in Japan. HUE, “STEP program”, was awarded this scholarship from 2020 for 4 years, to encourage the students and promote its understandings between the universities.

2 Scholarship

Our program of 2023 is under examination by Jasso. Then, it's justa temporary one.

■ Eligibility

Students who;

1. have the nationality of a country that has a diplomatic relations with Japan(Taiwan is included)
2. are officially nominated by partner university to be an exchange students
3. don't hold Japanese nationality
4. are able to obtain "student" visa status
5. will continue his/her studies to earn the degree at home universities after completing the HUE program
6. will not receive any other scholarships awarded for the exchange study at Hiroshima University of Economics. NOT exceeding the 80,000yen per month

7. must submit a questionnaire that demonstrating the academic excellence, after completing the program at HUE.
8. have a minimum of 2.30 GPA(of 4.00), which is calculated by the JASSO method below, based on a transcript of the previous academic year.

$$\frac{[(\text{No.of GP3 credits}) \times 3] + [(\text{No.of GP2 credits}) \times 2] + [(\text{No.of GP1 credits}) \times 1] + [(\text{No.of GP0 credits}) \times 0]}{\text{Total Number of Registered Credits}}$$

※Round off to 2 decimal places, for instance, if your GPA comes to 2.788, it will be rounded 2.79.
